UCSF School of Dentistry unites cell and molecular biologists, materials scientists, epidemiologists and clinicians to better understand the underlying causes of oral and craniofacial diseases and disorders, and to develop new treatments and strategies for prevention and early intervention. UCSF faculty engage in cutting-edge research that leads to scientific breakthroughs that drive the future development of dental education.

The school ranks first among all U.S. dental schools in research funding from the National Institutes of Health. This amounted to \$17.6 million for fiscal year 2002. The school has held this first-place ranking for the past 12 years. Student exposure to revolutionary research creates an unparalleled academic and scientific learning environment.

The school has many centers and programs for creativity and research, including:

- ▶ Craniofacial and Mesenchymal Biology program;
- ▶ Biomaterials and Biophysical Sciences and Engineering;
- ▶ Center for the Health Professions;
- ▶ UC San Francisco AIDS Specimen Bank;
- ▶ Oral AIDS Center;
- ▶ Oral Cancer Research Program;
- ▶ Center to Address Disparities in Children's Oral Health; and
- ▶ SICCA, an international registry research network dedicated to the study of Sjögren's Syndrome.
