Dr. Ronni Brown is public health dentist and currently practices at the Sonoma County Main Adult Detention Facility in Santa Rosa, California.

Dr. Brown received her B.S., D.D.S. and M.P.H. degrees from the University of California, Los Angeles. She completed post-graduate residencies in dental practice at the Veteran's Administration Medical Center, San Francisco and dental public health at the University of California, San Francisco.

Her research on the oral effects of methamphetamine, has garnered international interest, with more than 700 reads and 10 citations. She is the author of the recently released best-selling book, "A State of Decay: Your Dental Guide to Understanding and Treating "Meth Mouth" and lectures extensively at dental conferences on how to recognize, communicate and treat patients with substance-use disorders.
